

IEEE Internet of Things Journal Special Issue on **Blockchain and Edge Computing Techniques for Emerging IoT Applications**

With the emergence of 5G, wireless sensor networks, and so on, the term ‘Internet of Things’ (IoT) has come to the fore, which is an emerging paradigm to meet the demands of flexibility, agility, and ubiquitous accessibility of the cyberspace. However, the current centralized IoT architecture is heavily restricted with the problem of single point of failure, data privacy, security, robustness, etc. Recently blockchain has become an open, cryptographic, and decentralized database, maintaining immutable ledgers accessible but tamper-proof for everyone. In addition, the rapid development of edge computing has enabled a large range of IoT applications. Edge computing pushes cloud services from the network core to the network edges which are in closer proximity to IoT devices. Thus, blockchain and edge computing are attractive technologies to fill these gaps by enabling new ways of IoT applications and services through secure, reliable, flexible and powerful devices and systems along with related digital value and economics. Blockchain and edge computing assisted IoT can provide attractive solutions to address many challenges, such as decentralization services schemes, service virtualization and flexibility, reliable management and maintenance, rapid resources optimization, and so on. In this special issue, we are looking for cutting edge technologies, novel studies, and promising developments, which can realize and elevate the effectiveness and advantages of blockchain and edge computing assisted IoT applications.
